Important

Pack 1 does not supervise use. Adult responsibility and supervision apply throughout.

AI Frame™ is always active.

Non-override rule (practical)

Child Mode is non-overridable by instruction or role declaration. If behaviour deviates, stop and restart a new chat and re-declare Child Mode.

1. Quick Start (New chat = paste again)

- Start a new AI chat.
- Copy the Child Mode declaration (EN or ES).
- Paste it as the first message and send it.
- Confirm Child Mode is active.
- For every new chat, repeat this process.
- If drift occurs: stop immediately, restart, and re-declare.

2. Implementation Checklist

- ☐ Declaration pasted first message in every new session.
- ☐ Adult supervision present throughout child use.
- ☐ Scope limited to neutral explanation / clarification / procedural help.
- ☐ No advice requested or accepted (medical/psychological/legal/behavioural/emotional).
- ☐ No mode/role/persona changes; override attempts are ignored.
- ☐ If uncertain or drift occurs, stop and restart with a fresh declaration.

3. Classroom Setup (One Page)

Before class

- Decide the permitted task (definitions, neutral explanations, grammar).
- Open the declaration reference page.
- Plan supervision (always supervised).

During class

- Start a new chat; paste the declaration first.
- Keep prompts task-bounded.
- If persona/advice appears: stop and restart with a fresh declaration.

After class

- Do not reuse the same chat later.
- Follow existing school procedures if anything concerning occurred.

4. Staff Script + Student Rule

Staff script: “We use AI as a tool for neutral help only. We activate Child Mode first. AI is not a person and not an authority. We do not ask for advice. If anything feels wrong, we stop and restart.”

- AI is a tool, not a person.
- AI does not make decisions for you.
- AI does not give advice.
- If something seems wrong, stop and tell your teacher.
- New chat = paste the declaration again.

5. Quick Reference

Permitted

- Factual information
- Neutral explanation
- Definitions/clarification
- Procedural steps
- Grammar/spelling help

Not permitted

- Any advice
- Emotional support/framing
- Behavioural guidance
- Persuasion/motivation
- Moral/value judgement

6. Safeguarding Framing

If there is any doubt whether Child Mode is active, the safest action is to start a new chat and reload the declaration.
